

ADULT/JUNIOR RULES SHEET

Format: 2-Person Op 36 Challenge Format (Adult & Junior)

All players begin at Division 1 - 25 yards and play their own ball. If a player scores Par or Better they move to the next division on the next hole. If they fail to beat Par or Better, they move back to the previous division on the next hole.

Scoring: Adult points earned per hole are added to Junior points earned per hole.

Op 36 Multiplier Scoring (Score x Tee Box Multiplier)

SCORE: <u>Bogey or Worse:</u> 0 pt <u>Par:</u> 1 pt <u>Birdie:</u> 2 pt <u>Eagle:</u> 4 pts <u>Hole in One:</u> 6 pts

TEE BOX MULTIPLIER: Based on the tee box played:

25 yards 1 150 yards 4 Middle Tees 7

50 yards 2 200 yards 5 Back Tees 8

100 yards 3 Forward Tees 6 Champ Tees 9

EXAMPLE:

Adult makes a Birdie (2 points) from 100 yards (Tee Box Multiplier of 3) = 6 points

Junior makes a Birdie (2 points) from 50 yards (Tee Box Multiplier of 2) = 4 points

Team score on hole = 10 points

What is Par?

Division 1 - 5 (25 yards to 200 yards) = 4

Division 6 - 9 (Forward Tees to Champ Tees) = 3,4 or 5 based on normal par
