- ▶ Provide a comfortable competitive environment for golfers to explore techniques, learn, and not fear making mistakes.
- ▶ Develop players into "Pace of Play" & "Rules & Etiquette" ready golfers.
- ▶ Develop players into individual golfers who can make decisions on their own.
- ▶ Provide a challenge point environment where golfers can track and see improvement.
- ▶ JUNIORS - Prepare junior golfers for regional, state, and national competition.
- ▶ JUNIORS - Educate parents on how to be a positive spectator and caddy for events and encourage their juniors development.

PRE-SHOT ANALYSIS

OFF THE GREEN

- How far from the green are we?
- Where's our target?
- What club should we hit?
- How big should our swing be?

ON THE GREEN

- How many paces are we from the hole?
- Which way is the ball going to roll?
- Where are you going to stop the ball?
- What is our aim point?

FINAL THOUGHT

LAST THOUGHT BEFORE THEY SWING OR PUTT

- Finish your swing
- Visualize your shot
- Keep your balance
- Have fun with it!

POST SHOT

WHAT DO I SAY AFTER THE SHOT?

GOOD SHOT

Let your golfer know! Give player high five, or come up with your own celebration technique.

POOR SHOT

- Perform mistake ritual
- Keep positive body language
- Ask questions and begin planning next shot.

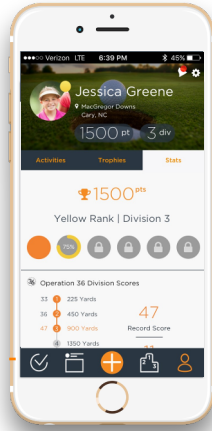
HOW DO THE MATCHES WORK?

- 1 Each golfer begins in Division 1 and plays that yardage the entire round.
- 2 The matches are 9 holes and the golfers target score for each division is 36.
- 3 Golfers log scores in the Operation 36 App after the round to keep track of progress.
- 4 When golfers beat the target score they will progress to the next division.
- 5 Train with friends and cheer others on to beat personal best each match!

PROGRESS TRACKING

LOG SCORES ON MOBILE APP

After the round adult and juniors can log scores on their profile in the mobile app. This will keep track of on-course progress.



JUNIOR BAG TAG TRACKING

We also keep track of your juniors record scores from each division by placing the number in each spot on the front of their bag tag.

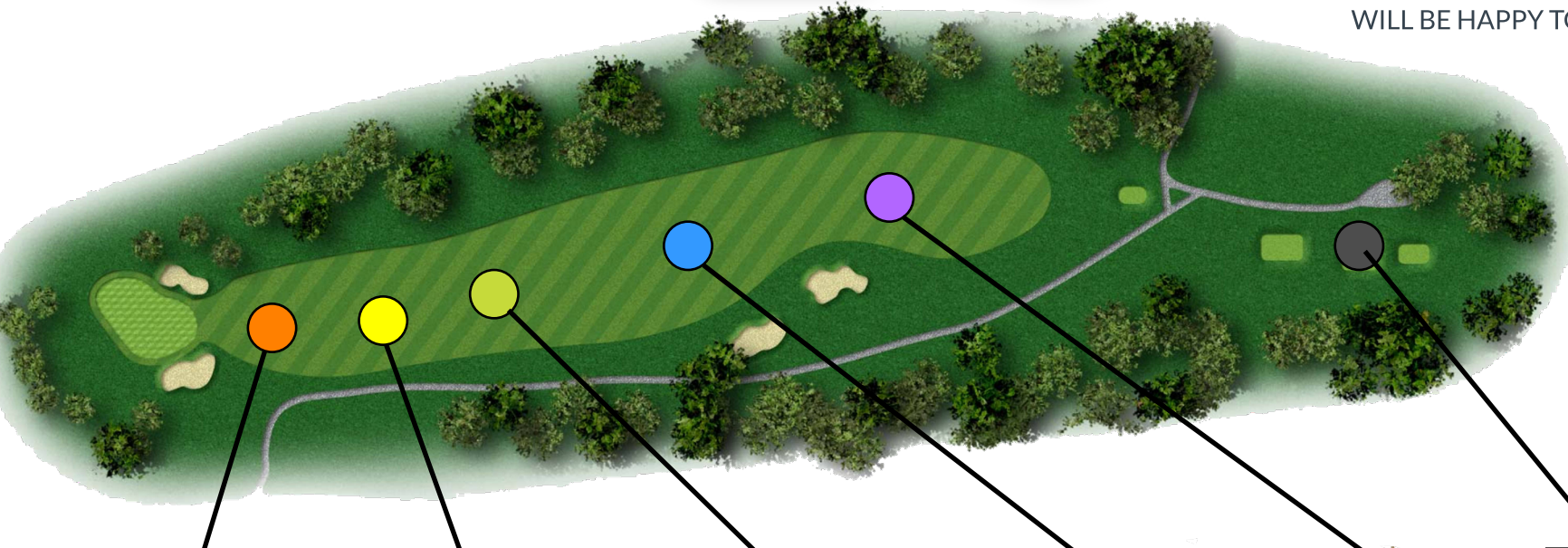
PLAYERS AND CADDIES SHOULD HAVE A BASIC UNDERSTANDING OF THE FOLLOWING CHECKLIST.

THE PUTTING PROCESS

1. MARKING & PLACING BALL
2. READ YOUR PUTT
3. PICK YOUR LINE & SPEED
4. 2 PRACTICE STROKES
5. STROKE PUTT & STICK FINISH

9 Holes: 225 Yard Course	9 Holes: 450 Yard Course	9 Holes: 900 Yard Course	9 Holes: 1350 Yard Course	9 Holes: 1800 Yard Course	Once golfers reach Division 6, they play from most forward full tee at facility. Golfers continue to progress back (as they shoot par or better) until they conquer every tee-box!
18 Holes: 550 Yard Course	18 Holes: 900 Yard Course	18 Holes: 1800 Yard Course	18 Holes: 2700 Yard Course	18 Holes: 3600 Yard Course
